Roads and Highways - Important Information

The roads here in the Kimberley can be unpredictable to say the least, particularly in our wet season.

Flash flooding, even on our highways can happen, water over floodways and if you venture off the bitumen in the wet, you need to pay attention and always adhere to any posted road closure signs and alike.

If you come across a flooded floodway, stop safely on the side of the road, being careful not to go too far onto the road verge because that could be water soaked, soft and muddy. If there is traffic banked up at the floodway, there is a very good reason. "Don't try to be a hero, wait till the flood water gauge shows zero", then cross when it's safe.

If you don't have the patience or the food and water to stay at the floodway, and you have enough fuel, head back to the nearest town. It's safer there.
